EE 281 LAB RULES

GENERAL RULES

- Do not eat, drink or smoke in the laboratory.
- Be prepared for the experiment. Read all the procedures thoroughly before entering the laboratory.
- Do the preliminary work and turn in your preliminary work at the beginning of the experiment to your lab assistant. *Students without preliminary work will NOT be accepted to the experiment*.
- Be on time. Students who are late for more than 10 minutes for any reason will not be accepted to the experiment.
- The week following the last experiment, there will be a make-up week. Lab hours for the make-ups will be announced during the last experiment. If you could not do an experiment on your scheduled lab session (because of no preliminary work, being late, being sick, etc.) you can attend to one of the make-up sessions. *You can attend to only one make up session. Students who fail to attend to two or more experiments will fail the lab, regardless of their other lab grades.*

EXPERIMENT RULES:

- You should bring your own pencil, eraser, ruler and scientific calculator to the lab.
- You will be doing the experiments in groups. Each group will work on the lab report together and turn in a single report at the end of the lab session.
- Turn off all power when setting up circuits.
- Never connect, disconnect, or operate a piece of electrical equipment with wet hands.
- If you have any difficulty or uncertainty about circuit elements, or the use of instruments, *do not take any action* without calling your lab assistant.
- When an experiment is completed, always clean up your work area and return all equipment to its proper place.
